



Chart-1: Year wise Govt.'s Economic Contribution in Child Development (%)






Chart-3: Govt.'s Economic Contribution in Child Development

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Govt. economic contribution in child development related data indicates that during financial year 2009-10, Govt.'s expense is 4% on educational development, 3% for career development and for health and social development is 3 and 2 percent respectively. Expenses increased up to year 2013-14 and now govt. expensed 6% on educational development, 5% on career development, 5% on health care and 4% on social development. Govt. contribution is increasing year wise.

Educational development of child trend includes parent contribution and govt. contribution. Parent's contribution data indicates that they are contributing on educational development of boys 5% of their expenses and 4% on girls. On career development of boy's parent's expense is 7% and on girls only 2%, this data indicates that career development expense on girls is less due to Indian social structure. Parents are concern for personality development and they are contributing for boys 4% and 2% for girls. Expense on health is 3% for boys and 5% for girls. On social development of child parent's contribution is 3% for boys and 5% for girls. Parents are contributing for moral development of child. Contribution is 2% of expense for boys and 4% on girls.

Govt.'s contribution data indicates that contribution on educational development of boys is 4% and 8% on girls. On career development of boys expense is 3% and on girls 7%, this data indicates that govt. is concerned for career development of girls. Govt. is concerned for personality development and contributing for boys 3% and 5% for girls. Expense on health of child is 2% for boys and 7% for girls. On social development of child Govt's contribution is 2% for boys and 6% for girls. Contribution on moral development of children is 1% for boys and 3% for girls.

Our govt. is expensing on extension of education, quality development of education, child development, health care, and social development also. Nowadays govt. has several plans for child care.
